FIGHTING LABOUR'S NEW TAX ON DRIVING

The Labour Mayor of London wants to charge you £12.50 to drive across the A406. Our Labour Council wants to charge you to drive anywhere in our Borough.

Despite falling emissions over the last ten years, Labour politicians in London, including Waltham Forest's Labour Councillors, are behind plans to charge you £12.50 every day you drive your car.

This will hit older people who will be charged to drive to Whips Cross, and people in low paid jobs who can't afford to change their vehicles. There's also no "residents' exemption" so all non-exempt vehicles will be charged.

London Conservatives oppose these plans. The cost of installing cameras is almost £1bn and the Mayor's office have confirmed this will actually make pollution worse near the North Circular Road through Chingford and Highams Park.

In January 2018, crime figures released by the police reported 77 crimes in Endlebury ward, including 13 residential burglaries.

Whilst these figures are a concern it is important to note that **over the last 10 years crime rates have reduced by nearly 30%**.

We know that one of the best ways to deter criminals is by building a sense of community. So, your Conservative Action Team is working hard to encourage as many roads as possible to form Neighbourhood Watch groups.

TACKLING CRIME

Endlebury is a safe place to live.

Our ward councillors are offering funding to help with set up costs, street signs and window stickers.

The Endlebury Neighbourhood Police Team report that crime number in roads with these schemes in place are far lower than those without. We are aiming to have a scheme on every road, investing in clear signage to help stop criminals from operating in the area.

Roads Resurfaced

We recently secured the re-surfacing of Colvin Gardens making for a much smoother drive for residents. We're still lobbying the Council to take action to improve Gunners Grove and Heathcote Grove as well as repairing potholes & pavements across the ward.



Protecting and Improving our parks



Our parks form the heart of Endlebury and we place great importance on protecting and enhancing these cherished green spaces. We quickly respond to any issues with maintenance, fly-tipping and vandalism and we have managed to secure funding for many improvements. Most recently with the painting of the gates and spreading of wild flowers at Mansfield Park.

Keeping Endlebury Road OPEN

When Labour Councillors proposed the closure of Endlebury Road, we mounted a campaign with residents to stop this. Our campaign was backed by almost 1,000 of residents and Labour dropped their plans. Without Conservative Councillors, Endlebury Road would now be closed.



Making our Roads Safe



With three schools in the area and a number of busy junctions, keeping our roads safe is important to local residents. Conservative Councillors have secured a number of safety measures, including zig-zag lines at Nevin Drive and a raised carriageway at the end of Heathcote Grove, as well as new Zebra Crossings and pedestrian islands. We will continue to work with residents and schools to make sure road users and pedestrians are safe.



Our New Bandstand

In support of our efforts to keep Ridgeway Park the vibrant heart of Endlebury ward, Conservative Councillors chose the building of a new bandstand and pavilion in the park as our "Making Places" project. Construction will start soon and band performances, outdoor classrooms and other community events are all planned to take advantage of this new facility - delivered by your Conservative Councillors
