NEW CONSULTATION ON LABOUR'S PLAN TO CHARGE YOU £12.50 TO DRIVE THROUGH WOODFORD

London's Labour Mayor wants to extend the Ultra Low Emissions Zone up to the North Circular Road. He's proposed delaying its introduction to 2021, but it will mean 6 year old diesel cars and older petrol models paying £12.50 a day to drive in the zone.

Our local Labour Party want the whole Borough included, which would mean you'd have to pay every time you moved your car anywhere in Redbridge!

London Conservatives don't think this is necessary. Air quality is improving and these proposals need a ring of cameras costing £800m to install — and we end up with the same air quality by 2030 anyway!
