PROXY VOTING

A proxy is someone you appoint to vote on your behalf.

The person you appoint may only act as a proxy for no more than two electors. However, a person may act as a proxy for any number of his/her relatives (husband, wife, grandparent, brother, sister, child or grandchild).

You must give the details of the elections at which you want a vote by proxy and give the reason for your application. Explain where you expect to be on polling day and why you cannot reasonably be expected to vote in person, e.g. *“I shall be away on holiday at.....on polling day”* or *“I am recovering from a serious accident/ illness and find it difficult to get about”*. If the application is because of illness, please state what the illness is.
