WOODFORD POLICE STATION — SAVED!

Local Conservative Councillors lead successful opposition to closure of Woodford Police Station

Jim, Linda and Michael are delighted that the campaign to save Woodford Police Station has been successful and that Woodford will continue to have a permanent police base in Monkham's Ward.

Woodford Police Station retains its local safer neighbourhood base and will become a Contact Point for the west of the Borough. The contact centre is open 7.00-8.00pm on Wednesdays and Thursdays and 2.00-3.00pm on Saturdays.

The changes are being made as part of London wide changes to policing being introduced by Conservative Mayor, Boris Johnson, which will see 86 additional police officers in Redbridge, with an extra 68 officers working in local Safer Neighbourhood Teams.

Your Councillors would like to say a big thank you to the Local Neighbourhood Watch team and all residents who joined in with the campaign to save our local police station from closure.

HAVE YOUR SAY ABOUT PARKING IN THE BROADWAY

Your Conservative Councillors are working with local traders to help boost trade by lowering parking charges.

Current charges are 30p for 15 minutes and 60p for up to half an hour. This contrasts with Station Road, Chingford where there is 15 minutes free parking and Buckhurst Hill where the charge is just 10p for up to 30 minutes. We're backing traders' calls for the charges in The Broadway to be reduced to 15p for 15 minutes and 30p for half an hour.

The Council is also looking at the one hour restriction on parking from 2.00pm-3.00pm. This could remain unchanged, or it could change to operate between 10.00am & 11.00am.
